New Delhi's Bobby John, global health advocate, is searching for an end to Tuberculosis. The dramatic disease made a huge comeback in 1991-1992. But if you fast forward to 2018, India is the world's largest Tuberculosis burden country.

India's prime minister has committed to eliminate Tuberculosis by 2025. 1.8 billion people; one third of the world's population are infected by Tuberculosis. To me, this seems unremarkable that this many people are affected by this disease. If not treated properly, Tuberculosis disease can be fatal. Tuberculosis is extremely contagious. All one has to do is cough, sneeze or spit. They spread microscopic drops containing the bacteria.

It's important to keep an eye out for Tuberculosis symptoms. A couple of them are, intense fever, chills, sweating, chest pains, fatigue, and extreme weight loss.

For treatment, doctors start patients on a four- drug regimen. The cost for this treatment is \$134,000 per person.

Canadian Politics by Sam Buoncore



Canada has joined Mexico and the U.S.A on a new trade agreement called USMCA, which replaces NAFTA. Wanting to modernize our trade agreements with Mexico and the U.S., Canada has spent 14 months negotiating a new trade deal. These are a few key items that were renegotiated. The U.S. wanted the supply management system that Canada uses for such items as dairy, eggs, chicken and turkey to be eliminated. But Canada gave a little more access to these markets instead. For example, the American dairy

market will have 3.6% more access to the Canadian dairy market. The egg industry will allow 10 million dozen additional imports when the USMCA becomes the law. The cost of drugs will go up because name brand drugs will be protected for 10 years from generic competition. Up 2 years from 8 years under the old NAFTA agreement. The one important thing that Canada wanted was the dispute settlement mechanism and they were able to keep this even though the Americans wanted to get rid of it. The dispute settlement mechanism is

used to settle trade disputes. All in all, it's too early to tell what this new deal will do to us and all those involved. My prediction is that many Canadian farmers and people are worried about this new trade agreement because they don't know what will happen to them. In the end the big winner here is Trump. He sold NAFTA to the American voters as the worst deal ever. Getting a new deal done, he looks like a winner or if getting a new agreement had failed, he still comes out on top by getting the Americans out of a bad trade deal.

Math Tips by Even Le

Math is essential for everyday life. Next month our class will be adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing decimals. Here are some helpful tips to make it easy. If you are adding or subtracting decimals, remember to line up the decimal points in your two numbers before you start. When you multiply decimals, multiply the numbers without the decimal points. After, move the decimal point the same number of places to the left as there are numbers after the decimal point in the two numbers you have multiplied. For example: 1.2×0.25 becomes 12×25 which equals 300. Since there are a total of three decimal places in the two

numbers multiplies, you would put a decimal in your answer three places to the left. Therefore, the answer for 1.2×0.25 is 0.3. People need to use math skills every day. These tips will make working with decimals easier to do.

Scott Cawthon and Kira-Breed Wrisley worked together to publish The Silver Eyes, a book about Scott's famous video game, Five Nights at Freddy's. Five Nights at Freddy's (FNAF) is a horror video game where you play a security guard in a pizza place like Chuckie Cheese. The player observes the animatronics through security cameras to make sure they don't make their way to their office and kill them.
