Step 1: What is the Question or Topic you will be writing about?

Step 2: Brainstorm interesting ideas that you can include in your essay. Pick 2-4 of your best ideas.

Step 3: Expand your best ideas and decide what reasons and evidence you will use to support your opinion.

Step 4: Write an introduction Paragraph. The introduction needs to include a hook (an interesting first sentence) and talk briefly about what you will be writing about. There is no information or facts given in the introduction paragraph.

Step 5: Write a concluding paragraph. The conclusion summarizes your points you have made, and includes thoughts feelings and wraps up your writing.

Step 6: Polish your essay:

- Where can transition words be added? There should be at least 5 per paragraph.

- Use descriptive language to make writing more interesting: Similes, Metaphors, Alliteration, Connotations, Comparison, Oxymoron, adjectives etc.
- Switch out frequently used words for more interesting words: (Said, nice, bad, good, interesting, mean, great, sad, happy are used too often, what other words can replace these?)
